

COMPOST FACILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOURS OF OPERATION:

APRIL through OCTOBER
Monday - Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
Sunday 12:00 noon - 8:00 p.m.

NOVEMBER through MARCH
Monday - Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Sunday 12:00 noon - 5:00 p.m.

1. Upon the receipt of an annual fee and the completion of the necessary application, a North Londonderry Township resident will be issued a key card for permitted drop off privileges and access to the facility during the above noted time periods.
2. Key cards may only be used by the property owner or an immediate family member of the household.
3. The site is available for residential users only - no commercial, industrial or institutional dumping is permitted. **Only items from the resident's property may be deposited at this site.**
4. Items permitted at the site are to be placed non-commingled in the clearly marked bins. Bagging, boxing, or tying of items is prohibited. Containers/buckets are not to be left at the facility.
5. Individuals who violate the rules of operation for this site are subject to having the key card revoked and loss of drop-off privileges. Regulations will be strictly enforced by the North Londonderry Township Police Department due to the illegal nature of dumping unsolicited items at the facility.
6. No smoking inside the compost facility.
7. The Township reserves the right to require and ask vehicle operators using the compost site to provide proof of identity, vehicle insurance and address of residency within the Township.
8. Individuals using the compost facility who cause damage to property or personal injury shall be liable for such damage or injury.
