

NORTH LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

November 18, 2024

The regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on November 18, 2024 by Chairman Ronald Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Others attending were Supervisors William Buckfelder and James Hartman, Solicitor Andrew Morrow, Manager Michael Booth, Assistant Manager Kristopher Troup, Chief Kevin Snyder, and Secretary/Treasurer Lisa Daubert. Four (4) visitors were present.

Chairman Fouché called for questions or comments from the public on the agenda items for this meeting. None were received.

Minutes from the previous meeting, October 21, 2024 were approved as presented on motion by Hartman, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

The Treasurer's Report for period ending October 31, 2024 was accepted as presented. All in favor.

The Police Report for October 2024 was accepted as presented. All in favor. Chief Kevin Snyder noted the Police Report has been placed on the Township's website and a copy was placed in the Police Department's lobby for public viewing.

Manager Michael Booth reported the Planning Commission did not meet on November 18, 2024. No business was necessary.

Invoices were approved as presented on motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Hartman. All in favor.

The first reading of the 2025 Annual Budget was discussed. A motion was made by Buckfelder, seconded by Hartman to tentatively adopt the 2025 Annual Budget. All in favor. Supervisor Buckfelder thanked the staff for their frugal spending.

Deborah Buckfelder, Township Representative – Palmyra Public Library Board submitted a monthly report. A copy is on file for public viewing. Mrs. Buckfelder noted Joanne Wendte will be resigning effective 12/31/2024 from the Lebanon County Library System Board.
